CLUB REGULATIONS

1. The Match Committee is "The Committee" under the terms of Rule 33 of the Rules of Golf and is in charge of all club competitions.
2. All competitions shall be conducted and played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, Local Rules and other regulations of the Club. Local Rules are printed on the back of score cards and temporary Local Rules posted on the notice board.
3. Players shall make themselves conversant with the Rules of Golf, copies of which are available from the Office.
4. The Match Committee reserves the right to alter entrance fees and conditions, and/or the dates by when matches should be played, depending on weather conditions or other circumstances. In such circumstances and before the first round of matchplay the draw sheet may be altered as the match committee sees fit.
5. All matches and rounds shall be played on the dates specified in the programme. The only exception to this regulation is specified in rule 6, following.
6. By mutual agreement **and** with the consent of the Committee, matches may be played prior or subsequent to specified dates, but in no case later than the date specified for the next match or round. .

7. IN THE CASE OF HALVED MATCHES

MEN'S SECTION:

(a) The players shall continue from the first hole, whether or not the match originally started there, until one or other side shall have gained a hole, when the match shall be won. If the match is on handicap, strokes shall continue to be taken as in the first round.

WOMEN'S SECTION:

(b) If the match began at a hole other than the first hole, then the hole at which the match began is the first hole for that particular match and should the match be square, the 19th hole shall be the same hole as that which the match began.

8. In all competitions players play on their handicaps of the day. Without an official handicap no player may participate in any club competition.

9. TIES

MEN'S SECTION:

(a) Ties in all competitions in which the Automatic Card System has issued a card, will be decided by the System. Competitions such as Ambrose, or Foursomes that result in one ball being used, will be decided by lot.

WOMEN'S SECTION:

(b) Ties in all Women's Competitions will be decided by count back.

10. In any final either player or side may request the Committee to provide an umpire.

11. All disputes must be submitted to the Committee immediately after the round. The Committee's decision shall be final.

12. No card for a club competition will be accepted unless it is signed by both player and marker, with date, competitor's name, Club ID and Member ID, the tee of the day, handicap index and course handicap. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. Each competitor has a separate card unless in a combined competition when player and partner score on one card.

13. Care should be taken when entering scores on cards, especially in 4BBB events, to ensure players' scores are readily identified. Torn or otherwise mutilated cards will not be accepted.

14. Grades will be determined by the Committee in accordance with the number of players entered.

15. In Saturday competitions players must check in, print card and pay.

TEE TIMES

Members are requested to ring the Professional on 487-9201 to book a tee time to avoid any disappointment or delay upon arrival. Often over the summer months Corporate Tournaments are held on Fridays. Please check with the Pro Shop.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Members are required to observe a reasonable standard of dress, at all times, on the course and in the Lounge Bar and Dining Room.
2. Children, unless members or accompanied by members, are not allowed on the course.
3. Do not buy balls from children around the course.
4. Members are insured against damage to Third Party property. Please contact the Manager immediately if you are responsible for any such damage.
5. Dogs are not permitted on the course.
6. Practice is not permitted on any part of the course except the practice area. See also Rule 5 of the Rules of Golf.
7. Players must not, at any time, move or interfere with sprinklers on greens and tees.
8. On all days players must give way to greenkeeping staff.
9. For fair handicapping ALL cards must be returned.
The Handicappers have power to arbitrarily reduce or increase handicaps. The ESC part of the card should be completed.
10. Members are asked to ensure clubs and equipment are adequately insured against breakage, loss or theft.

COMPETITION

All cards must be signed by the scorer, the competitor and return with correct handicap index, course handicap, tees played and adjusted gross immediately on completion of a round.

Dates fixed for completion of rounds in match play events will be strictly adhered to.

The Match Committee reserves the right to make alterations to the programme.

Walk smartly between shots. Replace divots and pitch marks at all times.

PRACTICE ON THE COURSE

In casual play a player may only hit a maximum of two balls on the Course Provided that they are not interfering with other players' rounds. Under no circumstances are players to use the Course as a practice area.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Check with Pro Shop for availability.

COMPLAINTS

Please direct these as early as possible in writing to the General Manager or Course Management Group.

SUGGESTIONS

Suggestions are welcome on any matters which could benefit the Club

Please feel free to contact the Committee or Board Of Management with your suggestions. You are welcome to leave any suggestion via the website/ members/ suggestion box.

MAIN EVENTS AND CONDITIONS

All match play rounds in this section must be played on the date specified in the programme and results posted on the draw sheet on the club-house noticeboard. Should this not be done, both parties will be disqualified. See also Club Regulations No. 6. Any dispute must be referred to the Committee.

In the event of exceptional weather conditions the Committee has the right to alter dates of play.

Motorised Carts can be used in Club Championships and Trophy Events.

SATURDAY COMPETITIONS

The draw for Saturday competitions closes at 5pm each Sunday. Late entries can be made Online. If unable to start at the advertised time, please ring the Club Professional. All players must report to the starter ten minutes before their starting times and be ready to tee off as directed by the starter.

COMPETITIONS RUN BY PROFESSIONAL

Sunday and holiday competitions are usually arranged by the Professional.

WEDNESDAY COMPETITIONS

All Members are invited to play on Wednesdays. Please arrive by 9.45am for the draw. Further details available from the office, phone 03 487 7076.

WOMENS COMPETITIONS

Womens competition days are Saturdays at approx 8.30am and Tuesdays at 9.30am with a mid winter 10.am start.

Fourball Knockout Cup - Players select own partner. Fourball best ball match play over 18 holes on handicap (limit 24). A 4BBB Medal qualifying round will be played, with 32 pairs to qualify and ties decided by lot. Blue Tees

Bayliss Cup - Players select own partners. Canadian Foursome medal over 18 holes, stroke allowance 50 percent of each pair's combined handicaps. White Tees

Goldsmid Memorial Cup - 4BBB Stableford and Cuth Gourley Memorial - 4BBB Medal, competitions over 18 holes on handicap with players selecting own partners.

Doug Cassells Men Single Par

K.M. Mackay Memorial Cup - Combined net score over 18 holes on handicap. 3 out of 4 score counts.

Lucifer Trophy - Best two out of three net medal rounds, played in conjunction with monthly medal rounds specified in programme.

C.H. Duncan Veterans' Cup - Played in conjunction with a Stableford specified in the programme. Age to qualify, 50 years.

HOLE IN ONE PROCEDURE FUND

- (a) The Hole in One Fund shall be financed by an annual fee to be set by the Board of Management which shall be included in the annual subscription account for each participating member.
- (b) A \$100 bar credit will be given to the lucky player to spend as they see fit. Ideally the player and his/her playing partners will have their thirsts quenched first then the balance would be shared around the room. This is to ensure that the player and the group actually get to share in the spoils. In addition to this the player who had the hole in one should be announced by the club captain (or next available committee member) on the day. The player will receive the normal trophy with his/her ball mounted along with their choice of a bottle of spirits or bubbly at their next club day. NB in the past this is only available for a club day or tournament. All other existing conditions remain the same.
- (c) Members scoring a hole in one at another club registered and under the control of the NZ Golf Association/Womens Golf New Zealand should hand to the General Manager/Secretary the card correctly recorded and signed. On production of a lounge receipt, a cheque for up to \$100 will be issued immediately or as soon as possible thereafter.
- (d) To be eligible the hole in one must be scored during what was clearly intended to be a full round with a marker, but it is not essential that the round be completed subsequently.
- (e) Marker must be a current playing member of an Affiliated Club.
- (f) The traditional purpose of the fund and payments from it is to enable the player to mark the occasion in the bar lounge with other members on the course that day or on a later date if so desired. Members holing in one at another club need only mark the occasion at that Club.

GOLF COMPETITIONS AND HOW THEY ARE PLAYED

These notes are only intended as in the general concept of how various competitions are played. They must be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and in particular the Committee must lay down the conditions under which a competition is to be played (Rule 20-1).

MEDAL OR STROKE

The score at each hole is entered on the score card, totalled and the player's full handicap deducted. The player who completes the stipulated round on the fewest strokes will be the winner.

COMBINED MEDAL

Two players as partners count their total net score for each hole.

PAR

In Par play the score is entered on the card in the same way as in Stroke play with the exception that where the score exceeds par for the hole, after allowing for handicap stroke (if the player is in receipt of one or more) the score need not be written in.

It is custom that when a player is beaten by Par, the ball shall be picked up. This helps speed up play. After entering the stroke score on the card, the result is marked in the column provided with a "+" sign for a win, a "0" for a half, and a "-" for a loss. At the end of the round the plus and minus signs are added and the nett result written in as so many "up", "down" or "all square".

A player is allowed his full handicap and the strokes are taken at holes as indicated on the card.

Where the limit of handicap is 19 or more, two strokes will be allowed on some of the holes. These strokes will be taken in the same order.

STABLEFORD

The popular method of playing a stableford competition is for the player to take strokes at holes as in a Par competition using handicap and to score points on the nett results at each hole. At the end of the round all

points scored are added up and the player having the highest number of points is the winner.

In scoring without allowing for handicaps a player who scores Par receives 2 points, or 1 over Par, 1 point. For a birdie or 1 under Par, 3 points, for an eagle or 2 under Par, 4 points and so on.

For example: a player receiving a stroke on a par 4 hole scores 4 giving him a net 3; for this he received 3 points. A player at a par 3 hole scores a 4 but does not receive a stroke; for this he would receive 1 point.

Handicap strokes are allowed as for Par, with the Stableford points being calculated on the net score for the hole. For example (1) A player receiving a stroke on a par 4 hole scores 4, giving him a net 3; for this 3 points are received. (2) A player at a par 3 hole scores a 4 but does not receive a stroke; for this one point is received.

At the end of the round all points scored are added up and the player with the most points is the winner.

COMBINED STABLEFORD

Two players as partners add their stableford points for each hole.

AMBROSE

Teams of four, eg on a par 4 hole, all players play drives; the longest drive (if most favourably placed) is selected as the team's stroke No. 1. All four then play from that spot to the green; the ball nearest the pin is selected as the team's stroke No 2. All four players then putt from that spot and if one succeeds in holing out, the team score for the hole is 3.

FOURSOMES

Two players play as partners, using one ball. The partners hit off on alternate tees and thereafter play alternate shots until the hole is completed. Scoring is done as for a stroke round with the total subject to a deduction of half the partner's aggregate handicaps.

NOTE: If either player incurs a penalty stroke (or strokes) it does not alter the rotation of play. In a foursomes stroke play competition of more

than one round, the order of play may be changed between rounds unless the Committee provides otherwise.

CANADIAN FOURSOMES

As for foursomes except that both players play tee shots at every hole and then continue with whichever ball they nominate.

Handicap allowance is 50% of the partners' aggregate handicaps.

AMERICAN FOURSOMES

Both players play tee shots at each hole, then play a second stroke with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in Foursomes with owner of the ball selected playing the third stroke. Handicap allowance is 50% of the partners' aggregate handicap.

GREENSOMES

Both players play the tee shots and second shots at each hole. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in Foursomes with the partner playing the third shot. Handicap allowance is 50% of the partners' aggregate handicap.

FOURBALL BEST BALL PAR

Two players as partners, each taking strokes at holes as in single Par Match. If one of the partners wins a hole and the other halves it, only the win is counted; if one halves the hole and the other loses it, the half is counted and so on. Again, to speed play, if a player is unable to better the partner's score, it is customary for the player's ball to be picked up. At the end of the round the pluses and minuses are added up and the net result recorded as in a single par competition.

FOURBALL BEST BALL MEDAL

Two players as partners each playing their own ball, both scores to be entered on card with the best net score of the two marked in the 4BBB column.

FOURBALL BEST BALL STABLEFORD

Play is in the same manner as above except that the better ball of the partnership will be allotted points instead of a plus, half or minus.

SOUTH AFRICAN STABLEFORD (Russian Roulette)

Played with a partner and combined stableford points multiplied together, ie $2 \times 2 = 4$; $x 0 = 0$.

SCOTTISH STABLEFORD

Played as a team of four (three) players take one players score on the Par 3's, two players score on Par 4's and three players score on Par 5's.

MIXED COMPETITIONS

The course par is 74 for woman and 71 for men. In mixed competitions additional strokes may need to be applied.

1. MEDAL ROUND

Women will add 3 strokes to their playing handicap.

2. STABLEFORD ROUND

No additional strokes are applied to the players handicap.
